

Captioneer is an extension for Adobe Premiere Pro to create captions from Motion Graphics Templates (.MOGRTs). Captioneer is compatible with Premiere Pro version CC2022 and later.

### **HOW DOES IT WORK?**

## INSTALLATION

- 1. Quit Premiere Pro if it is running.
- 2. Download and install the free ZXP/UXP Installer from:
  - a. <u>https://aescripts.com/learn/zxp-installer/</u>
- 3. Drag **Captioneer.zxp** onto the ZXP/UXP Installer to install the extension.
- 4. Open Premiere Pro.
- 5. Navigate to the menu bar and click **Window > Extensions > Captioneer** to open the extension.



To activate a license, click the **Settings** gear inside Captioneer extension window. Click the **Activate License** button and enter your email and license code.

# **MOTION GRAPHICS TEMPLATES**

Captioneer comes with 10 Motion Graphics Templates (.MOGRTs). They are designed for vertical social media, but flexible for any resolution.

MOGRTs load inside the **Select Mogrt** tab.




By default, Captioneer loads MOGRTs from Premiere Pro's Local Templates Folder (the "Motion Graphics Templates" directory):

Windows: C:\Users\\*username\*\AppData\Roaming\Adobe\Common\Motion Graphics Templates\

Mac OS: ~/Users/\*username\*/Library/Application Support/Adobe/Common/Motion Graphics Templates/

You can add or remove any folder for use with the extension.

To load MOGRTs from a custom folder, click the **Settings** gear inside the extension window. Hit **Add Folder** and browse to your custom folder location.



Captioneer is compatible with any MOGRT exported from Adobe After Effects.



- \*Note that MOGRT files are not backwards-compatible with older versions of Premiere (i.e. a MOGRT exported from AE 2022 can be opened in Pr 2022+, while a MOGRT exported from AE 2024 must be opened in Pr 2024+).

# FAQ

#### I installed Captioneer but it won't open in Premiere Pro.

There was an issue with your installation. Please uninstall and reinstall the latest version of Captioneer. Follow the re-install instructions for Mac & PC <u>here</u>.

#### Fonts in the MOGRTs aren't syncing.



Captioneer MOGRTs use Adobe Fonts to auto sync fonts. If font sync fails, go to **Essential Graphics > Browse** and manually drag the .mogrt onto the timeline to trigger auto sync via Creative Cloud.

Alternatively, hit the "i" icon to see the name of the font. Go to <u>fonts.adobe.com</u> and manually sync fonts.

#### How many licenses do I get?

Each license allows 1 active computer. For additional computers, purchase multiple Subscriptions or Lifetime licenses.

#### Can I move my license between computers?

Yes, you can switch computers at any time. Go to **Settings > Remove License** to deactivate your license key, and then activate your key on the other computer. Or you can use the online <u>License Manager</u>.

#### I received an error code.
